Raiders win national title

The First Lutheran/Emanuel Raiders girls basketball team wrapped up an undefeated season in the finest of forms, claiming the squad's first-ever national championship by winning the Lutheran Basketball Association of America National Basketball Tournament on Sunday, March 22.

"The community should be proud of this team," head coach Kathy L. Mackenthun said at a reception for the team on Thursday, March 26. "They are all very respectful, humble and coachable girls."

The Raiders put the finishing touches on their 31-0 campaign by winning all four games played at the national tournament, held in Val-

paraiso, Ind. March 19-22.

Among those teams defeated by the Raiders were: Prince of Peace Christian (Carrollton, Texas) 40-14, Wyneken Memorial (Decatur, Ind.) 31-25, Holy Ghost/Trinity Lutheran (Monroe, Mich.) 29-20, and First Immanuel Lutheran (Cedarburg, Wis.) 27-17.

"By the end of the season, they were the poster girls for teamwork," Mackenthun said. "That's what got us to the championship game. Each girl brought their own special talents."

Raiders guard Abby Mackenthun was named Tournament MVP for her efforts in the championship run.

It is the second time in the 69-year history of the tourna-

ment that a Minnesota team has secured the title.

"It is historic and these girls greatly deserve it," coach Kathy M. Mackenthun said at the reception. "They are great examples to younger kids."

It was the third consecutive season that the Raiders competed in the national tournament and the first as state champion. The team also played in the last two tournaments as an at-large invitee.

"Going to nationals was the experience of our lives," Raiders player Kacie Miller said at the reception while thanking the assembly of fans, many of whom traveled to Indiana for the competition. "The encouragement we received was the key to helping us win."

The news wasn't as fortunate for GSL's three-man contingent of Mason Goettl, Garrett Ober and Keaton Anderson in the boys' game.

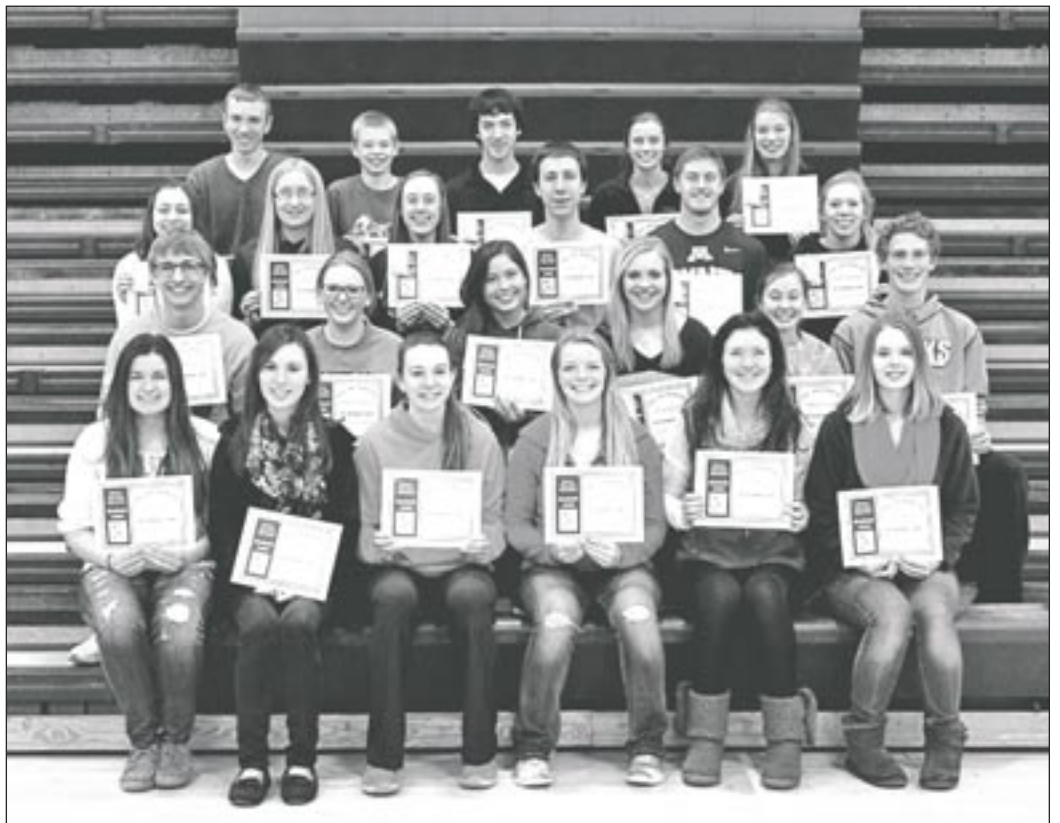
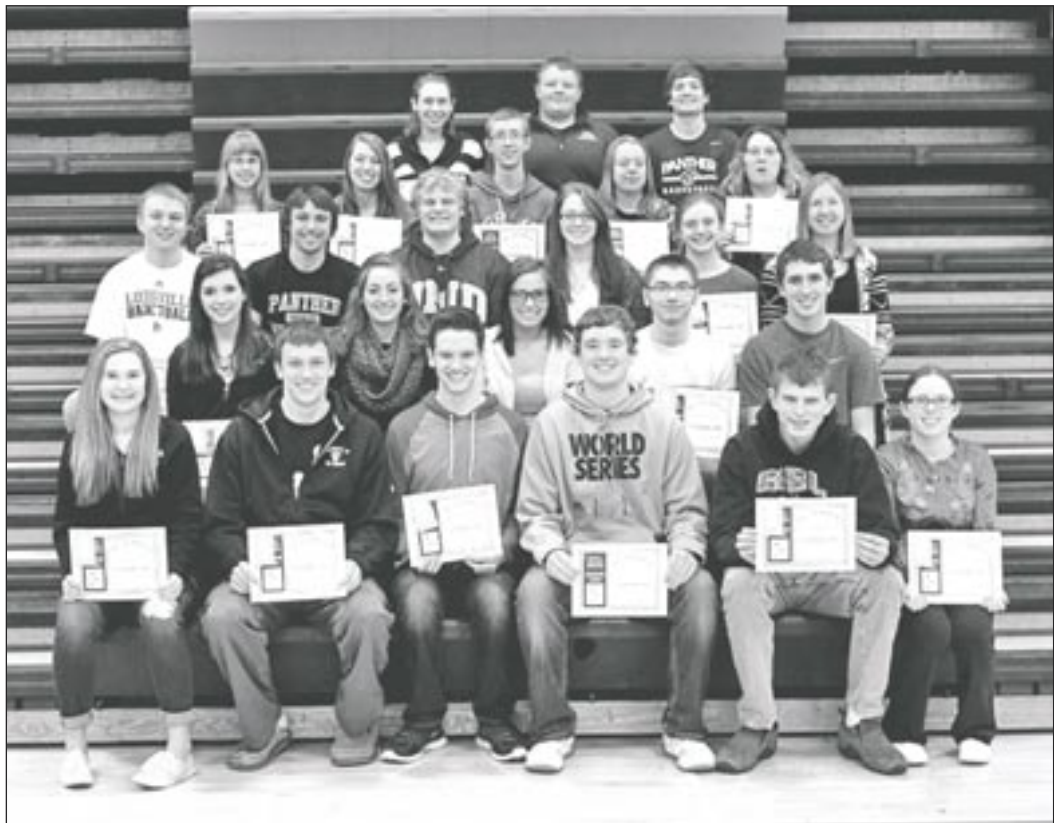
The three-point shooting of their Raspberry squad could not contend with the overwhelming inside game of the Grays, who claimed a 102-78 victory.

Anderson and Ober also competed in the boys' slam dunk competition, with Prafke taking part in the girls' three-point contest.



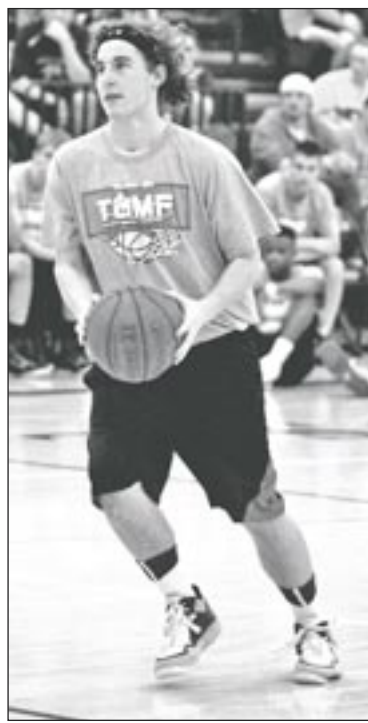
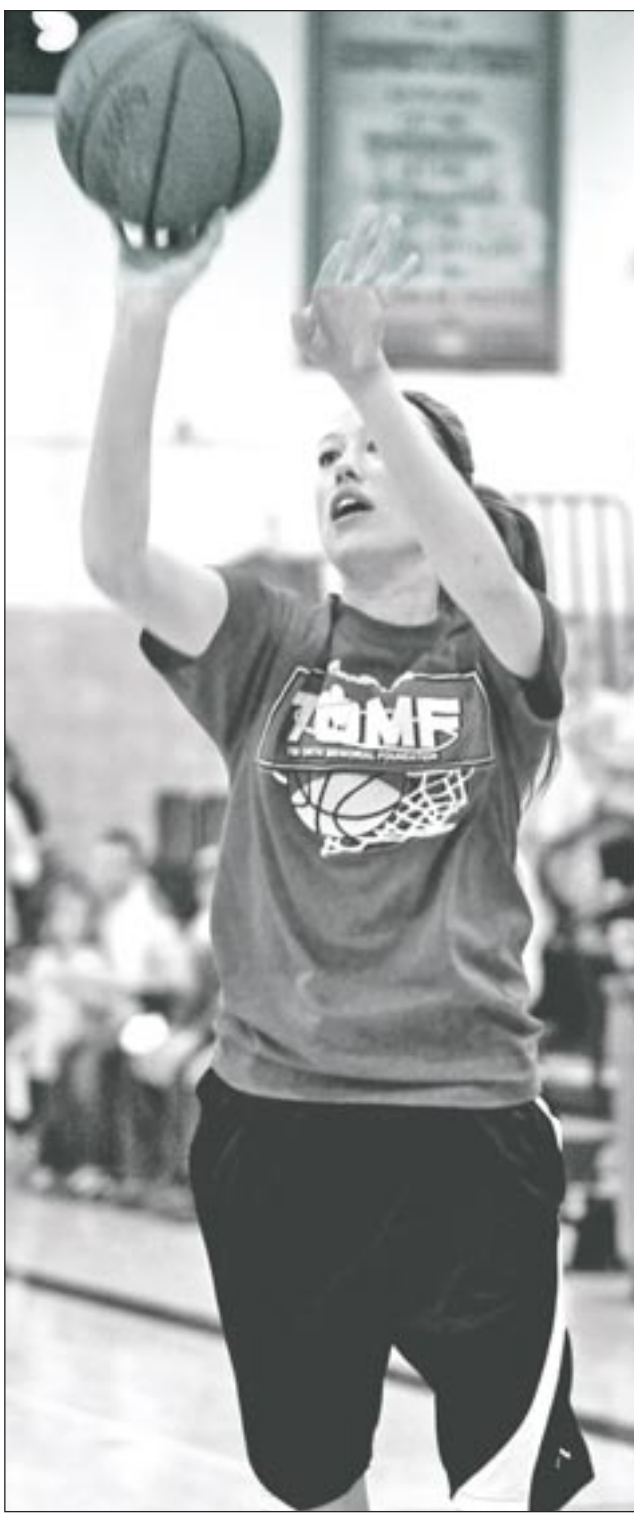

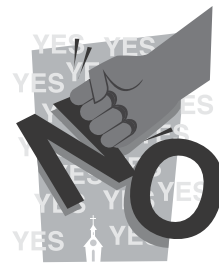
Pastor's Corner

Councilor Schrupp motioned to set the public hearing for the 2015 Lincoln Park Area Improvement Project with the following resolution:

RESOLUTION O. (2015-14) DECLARING COST TO BE ASSESSED, ORDERING PREPARATION OF PROPOSED ASSESSMENT, AND CALLING FOR HEARING ON PROPOSED ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, costs have been determined for the Lincoln Park Area Street and Utility Improvement Project, for the construction of sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, concrete curb and gutter, aggregate base, bituminous street surfacing, sidewalks, turf restoration, and miscellaneous items required to properly complete the improvements, and the estimated final contract price for such improvements is \$5,605,140.40, and the estimated final expenses incurred or to be incurred in the making of such improvements amount to \$1,063,000.00 so that the estimated final total cost of the improvements will be \$6,668,140.40.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GLENCOE, MINNESOTA: The portion of the cost of such improvement to be paid by the city is hereby declared to be \$5,337,379.20, and the portion of the cost to be assessed against benefited property owners is declared to be \$1,330,761.20.

Assessment shall be payable in equal annual installments extending over a period of 15 years, the first of the installments to be payable on or before the first Monday in January, 2016, and shall bear interest at the rate of 5.00 percent per annum from the date of the adoption of the assessment resolution.

The City Administrator, with the assistance of the consulting engineer, shall forthwith calculate the proper amount to be specially assessed for such improvement against every assessable lot, piece or parcel of land within the district affected, without regard to cash valuation, as provided by law, and he shall file a copy of such proposed assessment in his office for public inspection.

A hearing shall be held on the 23rd day of March, 2015, in the Glencoe City Hall at 7:15 p.m., to pass upon such proposed assessment and at such time and place all persons owning property affected by such improvement will be given an opportunity to be heard with reference to such assessment.

The City Administrator is hereby directed to cause a notice of the hearing on the proposed assessment to be published once in the official newspaper at least two weeks prior to the hearing, and shall state in the notice the total cost of the improvement. The City Administrator shall also cause mailed notice to be given to the owner of each parcel described in the assessment roll not less than two weeks prior to the hearing.

The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the McLeod County Auditor-Treasurer, pay the whole of the assessment on such property with interest accrued to the date of payment, to the City Administrator, except that no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid by October 31, 2015. He may at any time thereafter, pay to the City Administrator the entire amount of the assessment remaining unpaid, with interest accrued to December 31 of the year in which such payment is made. Such payment must be made before November 15 or interest will be charged through December 31 of the succeeding year.

Councilor Dietz seconded and upon a roll call vote all members present voted in favor. Whereupon

said resolution was adopted and approved.

Mayor Wilson opened the public hearing for the alley vacation in Glenview Woods. All utilities have signed off on the vacation. Homeowner Jeremy Geib will be purchasing 1/2 the alley from the adjoining property owner for building a garage.

Industrial Hygiene Services Corporation recommended awarding the low bid of Twin City Abatement Technologies, Inc. for the abatement services. Councilor Schrupp motioned and Councilor Ziemer seconded the approval of the low bid of Twin City Abatement Technologies, Inc in the amount of \$5,500.00. All members present voted in favor. Three bids were received for the demolition of the building located at 1218 Greeley Avenue North. Low bid was in the amount of \$19,450.00 from MJ Neisen of Brownton, Minnesota.

Glencoe-Silver Lake Independent School District 2859 is proposing a bond referendum on May 12, 2015 to finance additions, renovations, a secure entrance, the repurposing of existing space at the secondary (junior and senior high) school site and window replacement at the elementary school. The estimated dollar amount of all projects, including bond issuance costs and capitalized interest, is \$24,190,000.

Though enrollment has trended downward over the last few years, the district expects student numbers to stabilize within the next few years. The proposed projects will facilitate the relocation of K-2 programs from Helen Baker Elementary to the secondary school site; a move that is expected to result in operational savings and improved efficiencies. Planned additions include a two-court gymnasium with locker room space, K-2 and 7-8 grade classrooms, kitchen space and a secure building entrance connecting the existing junior and senior high school buildings. Other proposed projects include a multi-purpose room addition to the existing field house and other miscellaneous upgrades at the secondary school site.

The projects would be scheduled for completion in the 2016-2017 calendar years. Cost estimates by project/location are as follows:

If the bond referendum is successful and bonds are sold, the debt service on the bonds will be eligible for debt service equalization under Minn. Stat. § 123B.53, subd. 3, if the bond schedule is approved. The amount of debt service equalization aid, if any, the district receives is determined annually and is dependent upon property wealth, student population, and other statutory requirements.

The school board believes they will have sufficient resources to fund the increase in costs associated with the proposed facility expansion and that the proposed projects are in the best interest of the district.
